

**Dr. Engku Rabiah Adawiah Engku Ali**



Dr. Engku Rabiah Adawiah is a member of the Shariah Advisory Council (SAC) of Bank Negara Malaysia (Central Bank of Malaysia) and Shariah Supervisory Council of Labuan Financial Services Authority (Labuan FSA). She is an independent Shariah adviser for Islamic securities issuance, approved by and registered with Securities Commission of Malaysia. Prior to her appointment as a member of Bank Negara Malaysia's SAC, she had advised and consulted several Islamic financial institutions and legal firms at local and international levels. In addition, she is also a member of the investigation tribunal for the Malaysian Bar Council.

At present, Dr. Engku Rabiah Adawiah is the Associate Professor at Ahmad Ibrahim Kuliyyah of Laws, International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). She teaches both Shariah and civil law; particularly on the subjects of Islamic transactions, company law, law of contracts and Islamic banking and securities at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Her research interest is in securities regulation, company law, Islamic law of transaction, and Islamic banking and finance. Her publications include articles in Malaysia's and international. She also presents at conferences, seminars and workshops on Islamic banking and finance.

She obtained her LLB (First Class Honours) and LLB (Shariah) (First Class Honours) from IIUM. Dr. Engku Rabiah Adawiah successfully completed her Master of Comparative Laws with distinction from the same university. She was conferred with a PhD in Law (Securities Regulation) from the University of Aberdeen, United Kingdom.
