Sheikh Ghazali Abdul Rahman is the Chairman of the Shariah Advisory Council (SAC) of Securities Commission Malaysia and a member of the Shariah Advisory Council (SAC) of Bank Negara Malaysia (Central Bank of Malaysia). He is also the Chairman of Technical Committee for Shariah and Civil of Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM), a member of the National Fatwa Council and the Accounting and Auditing Organization for Islamic Financial Institutions (AAOIFI) (Bahrain) Shariah Board.

At present, Sheikh Ghazali Abdul Rahman is the Shariah Advisor to the Attorney General Chamber, Putrajaya (federal administrative centre of Malaysia).

His dedicated involvement in Islamic law as well as in his community has made him qualified to receive the Tokoh Maal Hijrah 1416/1995 (Maal Hijrah Prominent Figure Award) at the Federal Territory level and Anugerah Penghargaan Maal Hijrah (Maal Hijrah Recognition Award) at the national level in 2007. His vast experience in the Shariah judiciary field has made significant and invaluable contributions towards Malaysia's Shariah judiciary system.

He obtained a Diploma in Law and Judiciary Administration from the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). He then pursued his study by taking a Diploma in Education at Ain Shams University, Cairo, Egypt and later a Degree in Islamic law at Al- Azhar University, Cairo, Egypt.
